Chase was a student at South Lexington Development Center where he formed special relationships with his beloved teachers and classmates.

He is preceded in death by an infant brother, Christopher Viars; a sibling,

Baby Viars; maternal grandparents, Kenneth and Peggy Foley; and paternal grandparents, Jerry and Virtie Endicott.
