Mr. Joseph Franklin Hiatt, 95, a lifelong resident of Thomasville, passed away Tuesday afternoon, March 3, 2026 at Hospice Home of High Point. Joe was born July 15, 1930, in Davidson County, to the late Ulysses Hiatt and Elizabeth Clemmons Hiatt.
